RE: INVITATION TO REGISTER YOUR CANE PLANTATIONS FOR CROP 2025

Crop 2025 registration of cane plantations is scheduled to start on **28th April 2025 and end on 31st May 2025**. By virtue of Section 40 of the Sugar Insurance Fund Act No 4 of 1974, you are kindly being invited to register your cane plantation(s) for crop year 2025.

You may call at any registration centre mentioned below from Monday to Friday (excluding week-ends and public holidays) and on Saturday 31st May 2025 from 09:00 hrs up to 15:00 hrs to carry out the registration of your cane plantations.

During the registration exercise, you are required to bring along the originals of the following documents:

- (i) National Identity Card;
- (ii) A recent utility bill (CWA, CEB or Mauritius Telecom);
- (iii) Title deed, Lease deed, location plan or any document justifying your occupation of the land under cane;
- (iv) Evidence of sale or purchase of lands;
- (v) Affidavit of Notoriété in case the former planter is deceased;
- (vi) Métayer Contract for métayer lands.

Please note that:

- (i) Registration card may not be issued if all the required documents are not produced at time of registration.
- (ii) Registration carried out after 31st May 2025 will be subject to a late registration fee.

As a one-stop shop service to planters and métayers, a representative of the Control and Arbitration Department of the MCIA and the Miller for your respective Enlarged Factory Area will also be present at the registration centres (except SIFB Head Office) for cane contract agreement.
